Circle Up



Families, the bottom line for today is "**Jesus is a Servant, so we can all be servants.**"

Activity - Grab a piece of paper and a marker. Trace the foot of each person in your family. Using both the Bottom Line and Memory verse, write them on the feet that were traced

Say: Let's write out a list of people who we can serve this week. Also, let's write out a list of ways that we can serve those people.

Do: Make the list and then act on the list. Keep track of the ways that you serve as a family. Revisit the list each day during the week. Try to serve a different person each day.

Let's practice the memory verse. Grab some crayons and a piece of paper for this activity.

The **memory verse** is John 4:14 - "But anyone who drinks the water I give them will never be thirsty. In fact, the water I give them will become a spring of water in them. It will flow up into eternal life."

Say: Using the memory verse, draw several pictures to match the verse. This is a great way for kids to connect pictures with the memory verse.
